SCHEDULING

1. Weekends (Fri-Sun) and holidays can only be scheduled for half-days during daylight savings time (Spring and Summer months). Bronze members may reserve the boats for full days during this time since they pay per charter. Every club level may reserve for full days during these days once daylight savings time ends (fall – winter). Half days are as follows:

AM TIME SLOT:

Spring/Summer 9am to 2pm, Fall/Winter 9am to 1pm

PM TIME SLOT:

Spring/Summer 2pm to sunset, Fall/Winter 1pm to sunset

- Club Manager will allow you to book the boat for any time frame you wish, you still need to abide by the half and full day time slots. If you only want to sail from 2pm-5pm please only block the boat for that time slot, this is considered a half day. Someone else may now block the boat from 6pm-9pm, also considered a half day. Suggestion, always allow for an hour buffer.

2. You can only schedule in advance up to 3-time slots per quarter on Fridays, weekends, and holidays. These rules do not apply to week days (Mon-Thurs), but we ask that you be considerate in your advance scheduling. This is NOT per boat but all of your reservations on all of the boats
3. **If small craft advisory is posted, you MUST have 103 to sail.** Check NOAA marine forecast for Puget Sound and Hood Canal
4. **If gale warnings are posted ALL PSSI boats are grounded.**
5. Advanced Scheduling is 48-hours or more in advance.

6. I Must have ASA 103 to sail overnight. \$50 plus tax per night fee (\$75 for Hunter 28.5). If you are taking the boat out on a weekend, number one above does not apply. One-night maximum for holiday weekends. The \$50/\$75 fee is charged AFTER your overnight sail. Please cancel 48 hours in advance.
 - a. EMAIL THE OFFICE AFTER YOU MAKE YOUR OVERNIGHT SAIL TO VERIFY. We notify our Boat Manager and maintenance staff of your intent so the boat is prepped and ready for your sail.
 - b. Your float plan notes must be added to your Club Manager boat reservation. PSSI reserves the right to adjust your sailing itinerary
 - c. You can only use a boat overnight for 2 nights within one reservation, unless otherwise cleared with the office.
 - d. We have a helpful guide on how to prepare for your overnight sail, ask us if you would like this emailed to you.

SAFETY

7. Please note the maximum amount of people allowed on the boats is five.
8. We think your pets are just as cute as you do, but please leave pets at home as they are not permitted on club boats.
9. Adult PFD's are available for you to use, children's lifejackets must be brought by you and fit the child.
10. Members may not operate/be under sail on any of the boats under the influence of drugs or alcohol. This is grounds for immediate termination.
